





Flag & Non-Flag Expeditions


The Bali Hai Expeditions



Vanuatu is a country in the SW Pacific, with 83 volcanic islands and 250,000 friendly people











Previously the New Hebrides, Vanuatu was the setting for *South Pacific*, and got independence in 1980 from Britain and France







Vanuatu is famous for volcanos, beaches, and land-diving into the dirt below...








...which inspired bungee jumping!

with circular tusks














First Bali Hai/Ambae expedition in 2001 found WW II plane and interviewed chiefs and villagers

archaeology mystery....






....evaluated Ambae's emergency

For 129 years anthropologists have stated or assumed that there are no female chiefs in Vanuatu




Codrington in 1891:

"Women are completely excluded from the *Suqe* of the men..."




Our 2016 Flag Expedition team arrived on Maewo to interview female chiefs






We finally found some female chiefs on Ambae & Efate islands










Mt. Manaro on Ambae/Bali Hai exploded in 2018 – 2019...










