Conclusions



So, where are they?





My estimate:

- 30% chance they crashed at sea near Howland, probably S not N
- 9% chance Marshall islands
- >1% other conspiracy theories
- 60% landed & died on Niku





IMHO Niku proven to

"a preponderance of the evidence"—but not "beyond a reasonable doubt"
